

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP DUES

SECTION 1. Membership dues shall be based upon a combination of population and total assessment valuation factors and/or sales tax revenues. The population of a member city shall be determined by the last census, or if none applicable to a member city, then as determined for the purpose of state allocation of motor vehicle fees. Said dues shall be as follows. In situations where a city falls into more than one category, dues shall be assessed at the lowest applicable tier.

For cities within Los Angeles County:

Under 10,000 population and with less than \$10,000 annual sales tax revenues	\$910.00
Under 20,000 population and/or less than \$150 million assessed property valuation	\$1,820.00
With 20,000 to 40,000 population and/or \$150 million to \$500 million assessed property valuation	\$2,366.00
With 40,000 to 60,000 population and/or \$500 million to \$1 billion assessed property valuation	\$2,912.00
Over 60,000 to 400,000 population and/or \$1 billion assessed property valuation	\$3,640.00
Over 400,000 population and/or \$35 billion Assessed property valuation	\$ 5,000.00

For Cities outside of Los Angeles County:

10,000 population and under	\$700.00
10, 000 to 25,000 population	\$1,400.00
Over 25,000 population	\$1,857.00

SECTION 2. Dues shall be paid in advance and annually by July 1st of each year. Any city failing to pay membership dues when due or owing shall become automatically suspended from membership and shall remain so suspended until said dues have been paid.

SECTION 3. The CCCA Executive Board shall have the authority to approve dues increases by a two-thirds vote, subject to the following limitations:

- (1) Dues shall not be increased more than once each fiscal year.
- (2) No single dues increase shall exceed five percent.
